<u>Call to Order:</u> The meeting was called to order by Wendy Zimmermann at 9:01 am.

Approval of July Meeting Minutes (pgs. 1-3) (vote)

- No discussion
- On a motion by Charlie Nusser, seconded by Nina Lohman, the July minutes were unanimously approved.

Approval of July Financials (pgs. 4-10) (vote)

- Greg turner reviewed notable July financial pointing out ICDD projects line from the balance sheet that included an overage carried over from previous fiscal year of \$18,242 that reflects a balance over \$35,000 for the July balance sheet. On the profit/loss side income reflected for Farm to Street, Octoberfest, and Taste of Iowa City ticket sales, as well as University of Iowa contribution of \$100,000. No particular notes on the expense report. Budget coming as expected thus far.
- Betsy provided additional comments regarding the payment process for power washing from City of Iowa City. Instead of payment following each instance of power washing, the city has paid the contribution in full at the beginning of the fiscal year. That \$30,000 contribution was received in July. Betsy provided some details regarding wired transaction for the winter Bunny Installation and hiccups with the process between Midwest One Bank and the financial institution in Australia. This reflected in an inaccuracy in the actuals for projects. The inaccuracy has been addressed and the balance are now accurately reflected.
- On a motion by Kristen Mondanaro, seconded by David Kieft, the July financials were unanimously approved.

Block by Block Presentation

• John and Anna presented a high-level overview of the Block-by-Block services. Block-by-Block is being explored by City of Iowa City in partnership the Downtown District as a possibility for enhanced and expanded cleaning contract.

Staff Updates

- Iowa Ave Repaving Updates
 - Project is on schedule and might come under budget a bit. Some business owners are hopeful to organize efforts to maintain cleanliness of the alley. Some challenges with alternate locations of the dumpster in the some of the street side parking spots. It is likely those temporary spots will need power washing after the dumpsters return to their locations in the newly paved lowa Ave. alley.

 - o Linn St. on street dining area is going well, and is operating and functioning as best as it has previously.
